

Kennedy Park Pool Rules 2026

Lewiston Recreation Department

The following rules and policies were created to create a safe and enjoyable experience for all visitors. Visitors who do not follow rules or policies will be asked to leave the facility.

All Kennedy Park Pool visitors:

- must have a 2026 Kennedy Park Pool membership. Memberships are free to all residents. Non-residents must pay a non-resident fee of \$10 per person. Memberships can be completed online, or in person. A new membership is required every year to ensure the most up-to-date information is on file.
- must meet the height requirement to enter the pool deck. Children under age 8 or who do not meet the height requirements shall not enter the pool deck without a sibling or trusted adult who is 14 years or older.
- must rinse off before entering the pool.
- pass a swim test before entering the deep end.

Pool Apparel

- No denim shorts or jeans
- Hijabs, scarves, and dresses must tied back or tucked in.
- Children in diapers must wear waterproof diapers. These are for sale in the pool house.

Pool/Splash Pad Safety Rules

- No loitering, running, jumping, or diving near, around, or in the pool facility.
- No hanging on/from, sitting on, or climbing fences or splash pad equipment.
- No toys, floats, or life jackets (no condoms, rubber gloves, or water balloons).
- Holding patrons underwater, rough housing, or other unsafe behavior is prohibited.
- No breath-holding contest.
- No profanity.
- No glass bottles are allowed in the aquatic facility.
- Smoking, drinking, vaping, or drugs are prohibited.
- No oil or Vaseline.
- One person per bathroom/changing room unless immediate family.
- No strollers allowed on the pool deck or in the splash pad.
